ADMISSION TO BSC NURSING COURSE under N.R.I. CATEGORY SEATS **Academic Year 2025-26 – Information Brochure & Instructions to the Applicants**

Applications for admission to first year BSC Nursing Course (Academic year 2025-26) in the Twelve (12) NRI category seats at this college are being invited.

1. GENERAL INFORMATION

M.O.S.C. College of Nursing is attached to M.O.S.C. Medical College Hospital which is a 1100 bedded multi specialty hospital. The College offers programmes in B.Sc Nursing with 85 seats and M.Sc Nursing with 8 seats. The institution has excellent infrastructural facilities for both academic and extracurricular activities. The college also has excellent infrastructure setup with clinical facilities available in the same campus. Students have been performing well in the University examinations. The college aims at the total development of the students. College has secured A+ grade in QAS - KUHS.

University Affiliation

The College is affiliated to Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur.

Prohibition of Ragging

Ragging/any type of misconduct towards any student either in the college campus or outside will be considered as criminal offence and will be immediately reported to the police. Perpetrators will not be permitted to continue their studies. Every student shall, at the time of admission, furnish a character certificate from the institute wherefrom he/she has passed the qualifying Examination, which would mention the status of his/her behavioral pattern especially in terms as to whether he/she has displayed persistent violent, or aggressive behavior or any desire to harm others.

Students and parents shall, at the time of admission, furnish an affidavit to the effect that the students will not indulge in any form of ragging.

The uses of cell phones are banned in the college.

Every student is required to adhere strictly to the code of conduct of the institution.

2. SEAT DISTRIBUTION

All the seats under NRI quota are open to all categories of applicants.

3. Eligibility:

To be eligible to apply for the B.Sc nursing course under the NRI category:-

- i. The applicant must have completed and passed the Higher Secondary Examination of the Board of Higher Secondary Education-Kerala OR an examination recognized equivalent

there to with at least 80% marks in Biology, Physics and Chemistry puttogether, after a period of 12 years of study. The aggregate marks obtained in the qualifying examination should be at least 50%.

- Rounding off of the percentage of marks to the nearest whole number is not permitted.

- Candidates who have not passed their qualifying exam from the Kerala Higher Secondary Board, the CBSE or the ICSE, shall provide an equivalency certificate obtained from the KUHS (Kerala University for Health Sciences)

ii. Applicants must be at least 17 years of age on 31st December 2025 (the date of birth being shown on the Matriculation or equivalent certificate).

iii. The norms of eligibility prescribed by the Indian Nursing Council / Kerala Nurses & Midwives Council / Kerala University of Health Sciences shall also apply.

iv. According to GO (MS) No.243/2014/H&FWD dated 06.08.2014, *"An Applicant who depends upon his/her Father / Mother / Brothers and Sisters (inclusive of first cousins) / Husband / Wife / Brothers and Sisters (inclusive of first cousins) of Father or Mother / Half Brother / Half Sister / Adopted Father or Adopted Mother who is working abroad"* will only be eligible to apply in the NRI category seats.

v. **The following documents in original to prove the NRI status of the sponsor and his/her relationship with the applicant shall be submitted at the time of admission. In no case an applicant is allowed to submit these documents at a later date and that non submission of the documents at the time of admission will result in cancellation of the allotment.**

- a. Candidates, who apply for the NRI seats should submit the Passport copy and Visa/Green Card/OCI Documents of their respective sponsors. The Job of the sponsor should be mentioned in any of the above documents.
- b. The visa of the sponsor should be valid till the closing date of admission in respect of the Medical and Allied Courses.
- c. In case, the employment of the sponsor is not mentioned in the above documents, the candidate has to produce the employment certificates of the sponsor attested by the Embassy/ Consulate authorities.
- d. The certificates clearly establishing the relationship of the sponsor with the candidate shall be obtained from the revenue authorities, as per the G.O (Ms) No.243/14/H&FWD dated 06.08.2014. Certificate showing mere Niece/cousin/uncle/aunt without establishing clear relationship link will be rejected.
- e. However, the relationship between the candidate and his/her father/mother, which are recorded in the educational certificate, maintained in the usual course of transactions by the competent authorities, shall be accepted.
- f. The candidate shall produce a sworn affidavit from the Sponsor in a stamp paper worth Rs.200/-. The same shall also be notarized by the Notary Public, disclosing that the student is dependent of the sponsor and that all expenses i.e. tuition fee and special fee, of the candidates for the entire course period will be borne by the Sponsor.
- g. All the certificates/ documents referred above shall be produced at the time of submission of application itself.

4. TUITION FEES: The Annual Tuition Fees for the course is Rs.104500/ (Rs. One lakh four thousand five hundred only) The tuition fees should be remitted as demand draft in favor of

the MOSC Medical Mission payable at Kolenchery out of the fund maintained by the sponsor in an NRE account.

Special fees: In addition to the annual tuition fees special fees of Rs. 23980/ (Rs. Twenty three thousand nine hundred eighty only) during the first year and 21230[Rs Twenty one thousand two hundred thirty only] annually, during the remaining years should be paid along with the tuition fees.

Apart from above, the students are required to pay Caution deposit and examination fee payable to the university from time to time. Hostel & Mess fee will be charged separately.

5. HOW TO APPLY:

- i. Application shall be submitted ONLINE through the website www.moscon.org. Before applying online, candidates should have a valid email ID and scanned copy of recent passport size colour photograph in JPEG format below the size 50 kb. Applicant should read the prospectus carefully before entering details to the application form.
- ii. Copy of duly filled application form along with self attested copies of the required documents and DD for Rs.1000/- (Rupees one Thousand only) in favor of MOSC Medical Mission payable at Kolenchery shall be sent to The principal, MOSC College of Nursing, Kolenchery.
- iii. The application form should be completed carefully; furnishing the entire information called for. Late and incomplete applications and applications not in the prescribed format will be summarily rejected.
- iv. Candidates are advised to keep the acknowledgement received / generated at the time of submitting the online application.
- v. Self-attested Photocopies of the following documents shall be attached with the Application (The originals documents will have to be submitted at the time of admission).
 - a) Proof of date of birth.
 - b) School Leaving Certificate (S.S.L.C.)
 - c) Plus Two/12th standard certificate
 - d) Mark list of qualifying examination (Plus Two/12th Std.)
 - e) A statement to show that the high school in which the student has studied has been accredited by the State/Country/University (if applicable).
 - f) Equivalence Certificate from Association of Indian Universities (if applicable).
 - g) Eligibility certificate from Kerala University of Health Sciences (if applicable).
 - h) Copies of all documents as prescribed in clause 3(v)

Candidates are instructed **NOT TO ENCLOSE ANY ORIGINAL CERTIFICATES** along with the application.

6. SELECTION AND ADMISSION

The merit list of eligible applicants will be prepared and published on the website www.moscon.org

The merit list will be prepared on the basis of the percentage of marks obtained in English, Physics, Chemistry and Biology or equivalent subjects in the qualifying examination. The marks obtained for the qualifying exam will be subject to normalization process as explained below.

This process will be done taking into consideration the marks of those candidates who apply pursuant to this prospectus only.

The marks obtained by the students in the relevant subjects in the qualifying examination conducted by various boards or authority shall be equated with the marks obtained by the

students in the same subjects in the qualifying Examination conducted by the Director of HSE, Kerala, by adopting the method of normalization.

Allotment will be notified online only and no personal intimation will be issued

An applicant who receives an online allotment will have to join the college within the notified date and time schedule by submitting the original documents and remitting the fees payable to the College. Hostel fees, special fees etc. shall be paid by the students at the time of admission. While reporting for admission, all the relevant certificates/documents in original should be submitted to the Principal of the institution. If the applicant is not joining the college as above within the specified date, the allotment shall stand cancelled and all his/her rights in the admission process shall forfeit.

If during the scrutiny or any time thereafter any discrepancy or tampering of facts is noticed, the admission is liable to be cancelled. The candidate shall be expelled and criminal action shall be initiated against them.

7. DISCONTINUATION AFTER THE CLOSURE OF ADMISSION

Candidates who express their intention not to pursue studies in the Nursing College before the last date fixed for closure of admissions will be eligible for refund of the 1st year tuition fee and other fees except admission fee. They will be eligible to get back their original certificates handed over to the College at the time of admission. In the case of students who leave the College midway, the right of the management for liquidated damages [it may be equal to the tuition fee for the entire course] if any, from such students will be determined by the competent "Civil Court."

8. OTHERS

All students who get selected should get themselves vaccinated against Hepatitis before admission. A certificate to the effect shall be produced at the time of admission or before commencement of the course.
